**Description:** Free standing edge protection to the roof of a three storey building.

**Site/Client:** The Queens Club, Palliser Road, London, W14 9EQ

**Brief:** Established in 1886, The Queen's Club was the first multipurpose sports complex ever to be built anywhere in the world and now hosts some of the calendar's most prestigious racquets sports championships.

Frequent maintenance access is required to the roof of a three-storey office building, however there was no edge protection and guardrailings were required to prevent falls.

**ecex works:** ECEX / Shorguard SG4 free-standing flat roof permanent guardrail system was selected for this job.

The system avoids the need for noisy and disruptive structural fixing, and with just four main components it is rapidly erected by trained ECEX technicians.

Using ECEX / Shorguard SG4 free-standing guardrail system and a compact vehicle-mounted hoist to transport tools and materials to the roof meant the installation works could be completed in normal weekday hours without disturbance to site operations or staff inside the building.
