

Case Study 9702

Description: High-level safe access to cooling towers

Site/Client: Evotech (UK) Ltd, Oxfordshire

Brief: Many cooling towers were originally installed with no provision for access to high level - The BAC towers installed at Abingdon based drug development company Evotech proved typical.

The site maintenance team, no longer permitted to use ladders, engaged ecex to design and quote for the installation of a permanent gantry with access ladder and all necessary guard railings, to enable essential PPM tasks to be undertaken in complete safety.

ecex works: With extensive experience of providing similar access safety solutions, and with reference to the BS / EN & ISO standards relating to such installations, ecex surveyed, advised and provided quotation and proposal drawings to the customer.

Following award of order, ecex manufactured and installed a fabricated, galvanised steel high-level walkway complete with all guard railings and kick plates, accessed via a vertical cat ladder with safety cage.
